# OLD AND NEW TASTE OF THE WONDERFUL VAL D'ORCIA



CHAPEL OF MADONNA OF VITALETA (Tuscany)

## DESCRIPTION

Meet your tour leader in **San Quirico d'Orcia**.

*Admire the façade of the Collegiate Church of San Quirico and Giulitta, a beautiful Romanesque church with Gothic and Baroque elements, with three beautiful entrances all different from each other. Take a step into the Church of San Francesco, also known as the Church of Our Lady. Let your eyes enjoy the beauty of Horti Leonini, a small but unique example of Italian gardens, designed in 1540 by Diomedeo Leoni. At the centre of the gardens there is a beautiful statue of Cosimo III de' Medici.*

Inside this elegant village there is a small **brewery workshop**.

*This is an excellence: craft beers produced with high quality raw materials as organic grains from Val d'Orcia and selected hops. In few years this laboratory gained a prominent place not only in Italy but also abroad.*

Visit of the laboratory with beer tasting. Afterwards, enjoy a visit to a **local farm** that produces both wine and extra virgin olive oil.

Some areas of Tuscany -such as Montepulciano have grown in importance and fame than others over the years. Today the wine production of the Val d'Orcia (UNESCO SITE) is particularly worthy.

Visit of the farm with extra virgin olive oil and DOC wine tasting.

*In case of nice weather the tasting will be done under a nice vine that cover from the heat of the sun and offer a remarkable view of the Val d'Orcia landscape; otherwise the tasting will be done in a small tasting room where you can fill the commitment of the owners.*

The farm raises horses used for the Palio of Siena that you can admire in the courtyard.
